Survey Dates and Times:



- <u>Survey Coverage:</u> The defined survey area consisted of industrial business locations. The circulator performed a complete coverage of all businesses within the Commerce City limits. A second attempt was conducted with any location where the owner, manager was previously unavailable (May 7, 2018). Prior to the second survey attempt, the circulator phoned businesses to advise them of the survey issue and to make arrangements to meet with owners or managers. (please see attached map)
- <u>Circulator of the Survey</u>: There were two circulators for this survey. Prior to the start of the survey, the circulators were briefed on the types of marijuana license applications, the areas to be surveyed and reminded to be remain unbiased in her approach to residents and business people. The circulator had with them a face sheet with the applicant business name, location and hearing information, instructions and the petition/survey issue along with signature sheets and a map of the proposed location. The circulator presented an informational flier that was prepared by the applicant, describing the facility and the retail, medical, cultivation, and manufacturing plans. (please see the attached information flier) The circulators used tally sheets to record all contacts, attempts and reasons for opposition signatures and refusals. At the conclusion of the survey, the circulators signed notarized affidavits of circulation. The original survey packets were pre-filed with the City Clerk's Office.
