MOTION TO REVOKE OR SUSPEND LICENSE AND REQUEST FOR SHOW CAUSE HEARING

COMES NOW, the City, by and through Rachel Allen, Senior Assistant City Attorney, and moves, pursuant to C.R.S. § 12-47-601 and Commerce City Revised Municipal Code Sec. 8-1105, for the Authority to revoke or suspend or such other penalty as the Authority deems appropriate the Licensee's Commerce City Tavern License and as grounds therefore states as follows:

- 1. 6171 LLC, dba The Hideaway Saloon, was granted a temporary Tavern License on June 20, 2018, for the premises located at 6171 Olive St. Commerce City, CO 80022.
- 2. On June 23, 2018, the Commerce City Police Department ("CCPD") responded to a disturbance at The Hideaway Saloon. CCPD Officer Ahlem cited an intoxicated employee for the municipal offense of Employee Intoxication or Consumption and transported her to her home. Please see attached Affidavit attached hereto and incorporated herein Exhibit 1.
- 3. CCPD Officer Ahlem stated in the enclosed police report that the Defendant was an employee operating The Hideaway Saloon while intoxicated. Please see attached Affidavit attached hereto and incorporated herein Exhibit 1.
- 4. Employee intoxication or consumption is in violation of CCRMC Section 8-1400. Not conducting the licensed premises in a decent, orderly and respectable manner is a violation of CCRMC Section 8-1300.
- 5. Probable cause for violations of the above provisions of the City Code exist to set the matter for a show cause hearing.
