

**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ANYTHINK (AKA RANGEVIEW LIBRARY  
DISTRICT) BALLOT ISSUE 6A**

WHEREAS, Anythink, also known as Rangeview Library District, has referred a ballot measure to the 2018 ballot issue proposing to increase funding by 2.2 mills, including an additional \$11.6 million in revenue for 2019 and any amounts raised annually thereafter, and other things as stated in the ballot issue;

WHEREAS, Anythink proposes to expand programming, for kids and teens, expand access to technology and computer help, expand service hours, and establish new facilities to keep up with growth in Adams County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:
