RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF URBAN DRAINAGE AND FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT BALLOT ISSUE 7G

WHEREAS, Urban Drainage and Flood Control District has referred a ballot measure to the 2018 ballot issue proposing to increase funding by 1.0 mills, including an additional \$14.9 million in revenue for 2019 and any amounts raised annually thereafter (an annual tax increase not to exceed \$1.97 in 2019 for each \$100,000 of actual residential valuation) and other things as stated in the ballot issue;

WHEREAS, Urban Drainage and Flood Control District proposes pay for the district's work in coordination with local governments, including maintaining early flood warning gauges to provide potential evacuation warnings, providing trails, wildlife habitat, and recreational access to residents by preserving parks and open space in floodplain areas, and removing debris, garbage, and obstructions from streams, creeks, and rivers to reduce risk to healthy and safety of residents, protect property, and restore natural beauty;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council of the City of Commerce City supports the Urban Drainage and Flood Control District Ballot Issue 7G and encourages a vote of "yes" on the November 2018 ballot.
