

**RESOLUTION APPROVING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR
THE PROVISION OF MUNICIPAL COURT VIDEO SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City) desires to establish regular weekday video court services from the Adams County Detention Facility in order to provide timely video hearings for in-custody defendants appearing before the municipal court;

WHEREAS, the Adams County Sheriff’s Office has agreed to provide such video services to the City and other municipalities, including the Cities of Brighton, Northglenn, Thornton, and Westminster, pursuant to the Intergovernmental Agreement attached hereto (“Intergovernmental Agreement”);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Intergovernmental Agreement is and shall be in the interest of the public’s health, safety, and welfare, for a valid public purpose, and supported by a public need and is hereby approved, substantially in the form attached.
2. The City Manager and the City Clerk are authorized and directed to sign and attest the Intergovernmental Agreement, substantially in the form attached, on behalf of the City of Commerce City.
