RESOLUTION AMENDING THE DIRECTORY OF CITY FEES AND CHARGES 2018-95

WHEREAS, the City Council previously adopted and subsequently amended the Directory of City Fees and Charges; and

WHEREAS, the Directory of City Fees and Charges has been reviewed by City staff and recommendations for setting fees thereof have been made to this City Council; and,

WHEREAS the City Council has reviewed the recommendations of City staff and desire to update the Directory of City Fees and Charges;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council finds and determines that the fees and charges established in the Directory of City Fees and Charges attached hereto and dated November 19, 2018 ("Directory"), including those updated through this resolution, are reasonable, are necessary and appropriate to offset and defray the direct and indirect costs of providing or regulating related activities and City services, do not raise revenue for the general expense of the City, and are in the best interests of the public;

2. The Directory is hereby adopted, effective November 19, 2018, to include the following changes:

- a. A new Section 14(H), Park and Recreation Vendors is established for the use of Cityowned parks and recreation property by outdoor vendors, including electrical hook-up rates at Bison Ridge;
- b. A new Section 19(D)(6), Alcohol Permit to Consume is established at \$50.00;
- c. A new Section 24(D)(6), Alcohol Permit to Consume is established at \$50.00;
- d. A new Section 22(H), Military Benefits is added to provide free access to the Outdoor Leisure Pool for members of the U.S. Armed Forces or Merchant Marines, or Reserve of National Guard members on active orders, and their immediate family (spouse and minor children or legal wards) and for Veterans who were honorably discharged from the U.S. Armed Forces and have a 50% greater service-connected disability rating – residents only;
- e. A new Section 25(J), Military Benefits is added for members of the U.S. Armed Forces or Merchant Marines, or Reserve of National Guard members on active orders, and their immediate family (spouse and minor children or legal wards) and for Veterans who were honorably discharged from the U.S. Armed Forces and have a 50% greater service-connected disability rating residents only is established for free; and

f. A new Section 26 Small Cell Telecommunications is established as set forth in the Directory.

3. All prior versions of the Directory of City Fees and Charges are hereby repealed and replaced by the Directory adopted by this resolution
