## City Oil & Gas Permit Applications

- To date, no official permits have been submitted to the City.
- All operators have asked (at the request of the city) that holds be placed on the processing of all Form 2A's, with the additional request of a 2<sup>nd</sup> comment period.
  - 2 out of 3 operators (Extraction & Great Western) have complied with this request.
- At that time, the city will provide formal comment during the time of the 2<sup>nd</sup> comment period.
  - Extraction: January 3rd 23<sup>rd</sup>
  - Great Western: Unknown at this time



### General Updates – BMP's

- Held community meeting (12/6) on draft Best Management Practices (BMP) document with Extraction
  - Approximately 90 members of the community in attendance.
  - Discussed extent of progress of document and items being regulated, such as air quality, water quality protection, noise mitigation, emergency response, transportation, etc.
  - The materials shown at the meeting (including a draft copy of the BMP document) are available on the Oil and Gas webpage at c3gov.com/oilgas, under the Oil and Gas Open House Section.
  - Input from the community is still being gathered and evaluated comments are still being accepted online on the Oil and Gas Webpage.



#### **General Updates**

- Continued meeting with FHU to develop Oil & Gas impact fee expecting a community meeting on fee study within next 3 months.
  - Initial data gathering phase complete currently generating model & proposed fee structure
- Continued to meet with Adams County staff regarding coordination on Oil & Gas issues.
- Council adopted minor Oil & Gas LDC amendments on 11/19.
  - The amendments are limited in scope to clarify and reorganize city regulations (including grammatical revisions) and avoid potential conflict with state law.
