  - At an inclusive playground, children of all abilities can interact with each other and do what all kids want to do: play.



- Timeline
  - -4-6 months to complete entire renovation.
  - -Current plan is to begin construction in Q1 2020.
  - -If total amount of needed funding is reappropriated, construction could be completed in Q1 2020.



## **Citywide Play Structure Philosophy**

Inclusive play structure philosophy options:

- 1. City has one destination inclusive play structure.
- 2. Destination inclusive play structures associated with recreation centers:
  - -Eagle Pointe
  - -Bison Ridge
- 3. Inclusive play elements included as part of all city owned play structures
