## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING AND TECHNICAL SUPPORT SERVICES BY MICHAEL BAKER INTERNATIONAL, INC. NO. 2019-17

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City ("City") desired to engage a third-party consultant to provide professional engineering services and technical support for the Department of Public Works ("Services");

WHEREAS, following a formal bidding process, in compliance with the City's Procurement Policy, the City Manager approved a Master Services Agreement dated July 17, 2017 ("Agreement") with Michael Baker International, Inc. ("Contractor") to provide the Services on a work order basis, subject to the limitation that the total compensation payable under the Agreement would not exceed a maximum aggregate amount of \$250,000.00 without approval of the City Council;

WHEREAS, the City has issued six work orders for various Services with a total anticipated expenditure of \$249,999.88 and desire to issue a seventh work order to provide additional traffic engineering and hydrology services through June 12, 2019, for the amount of \$85,000 ("Work Order No. 7");

WHEREAS, the additional anticipated cost to the City of Work Order No. 7 will cause the aggregate amount to be expended under the Agreement to exceed \$250,000.00, and, pursuant to the City's procurement policies and the City Manager's commitment to the City Council, the City Council must approve any procurement in excess of \$250,000.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Agreement and Work Order No. 7 are found to be in the best interests of the City.
- 2. The City Manager is authorized to negotiate and execute Work Order No. 7 pursuant to the Agreement for an amount not to exceed \$85,000.00.
