## Characteristics of a Good Budget Process

- Incorporates a long-term perspective
- Establishes linkages to broad organizational goals (Work Plan)
- Focuses budget decisions on results and outcomes
- Involves and promotes effective communication with stakeholders
- Provides incentives to management and employees

### **Additional City Council Direction**

- —Draft an ordinance to regulate Metro Districts and bring information on costs/impacts of
  - Not allowing metro districts at all
  - Cause/effect of different regulation options (stricter and lighter, types)
- —Implement the proposed citizen engagement schedule with additional engagement events

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- Add a Spanish only outreach (coffee/pilsner)
- Add 2 more events to ensure both north and south have coffee/pilsner events
- —Develop proposal and budget to expand Council's engagement through social media in 2020
