

**RESOLUTION DECLARING SUPPORT OF PUBLIC ART INSTALLATION  
FOR TOWER ROAD**

**NO. 2019-79**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City ("City") approved a 1-percent public art funding program in 2014 to provide a means to fund the acquisition of public art by the City, which shall become part of the City's public art collection;

WHEREAS, the City's Public Art Master Plan identifies a process for public art administration and commissioning of artworks in spaces accessible to the public;

WHEREAS, the 1% funding requirement applies to the city's voter-approved capital improvement program projects, including Fronterra Park;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Public Art Master Plan, the Fronterra Park Art Selection Committee has selected public art proposal by Lisa Russell;

WHEREAS, on July 9, 2019, the Commerce City Cultural Council reviewed the selection committee's recommendation for Fronterra Park and announced its unanimous support for the selection of art proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Commerce City Cultural Council formally advances the recommendations and requests that City Council adopt a resolution in support of this public art commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council accepts the recommendation by the Commerce City Cultural Council and declares its support for the public art project by artist Lisa Russell for placement in Fronterra Park consistent with the Commerce City Public Art Master Plan.
