

**RESOLUTION APPROVING GRANT OF REVOCABLE LICENSE TO SOUTH
ADAMS COUNTY WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the South Adams County Water and Sanitation District, acting by and through its South Adams County Water and Sanitation District Activity Enterprise, has requested, and the City of Commerce City (“City”) is amenable to granting, a revocable license to install, maintain, and monitor two (2) water monitoring wells on City property at Olive Park and Leyden Park as set forth in, and subject to, the attached Revocable License Agreement for Water Monitoring Wells (“License”);
