## Exhibit H – Air Quality Monitoring Fees

Operator agrees to pay the following fees for air quality monitoring and related costs. In the event that CDPHE or COGCC rules are implemented that require Operator, at its expense, to perform substantially equivalent testing to that being performed by the City, then once the CDPHE or COGCC-mandated testing commences, Operator shall be relieved of the requirement to pay further fees where such CDPHE or COGCC-mandated testing is duplicative.

**Incident Sampling:** Operator agrees to pay the costs for all air quality sampling or monitoring as reasonably required in response to a reportable safety event, as defined by COGCC Rule 602(c), or a reported and substantiated nuisance that occurs outside of drilling and completion operations. Such costs will be payable within one month of invoicing.

<u>Continuous Monitoring – Life of Wells</u>.....\$10,000 per Well Site per year\*\* Payable 90 days prior to construction of each Well Site then by January 31 each year thereafter until all wells at each Well Site are plugged and abandoned.

\*\* Such amount shall be adjusted each year by the increase or decrease in the Consumer Price Index issued by the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics for the Denver — Boulder metropolitan area.
