

**RESOLUTION REGARDING POSTING LOCATIONS FOR ORDINANCES AND  
PUBLIC MEETINGS**

**NO. 2019-121**

WHEREAS, the Colorado Open Meetings Law was enacted by the Colorado State Legislature on April 29, 1991, and this law declares that the formation of public policy is public business and may not be conducted in secret; and

WHEREAS, this City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Commerce City to post a listing of public meetings as provided in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Open Meetings Law also stipulates that the public place, or places, for posting such notices shall be designated annually; and

WHEREAS, Section 5.6 of the Commerce City Home Rule Charter was amended by the voters of Commerce City at the November 3, 2015, Coordinated Election to require council to designate two public places in the City of Commerce City for the posting of ordinances, except for emergency ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY AS FOLLOWS:

- A. Posting locations to give notice of public meetings and ordinances, except for emergency ordinances, shall be as follows:
  - 1. Civic Center Atrium, 7887 E. 60th Avenue
  - 2. Commerce City website [www.c3gov.com](http://www.c3gov.com)
