

RESOLUTION AMENDING COUNCIL POLICY 2

NO. 2020-03

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce City enacted certain policies pursuant to Section 4.27 of the City Charter, which provides that the City Council “shall determine its own organization, rules and order of business . . . ;”

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend Council Policies 2 as set forth herein, pursuant to Section 4.27 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that these policies, as amended, are necessary and appropriate to promote the efficient and orderly conduct of municipal business, to ensure the validity of municipal proceedings, and to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the public;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

1. Council Policy #CP-2(D)(1) is amended to read as follows: “Committee areas belong to the whole Council; Council appointees are not seen as territorial. At least three (3) members of Council will be appointed to each committee consistent with Council Policy #CP-3, but that does not exclude other Council members who have not been appointed from participating in the discussion of and voting on committee business, if present.”
