

**RESOLUTION APPROVING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
ADAMS COUNTY, COLORADO AND THE CITIES OF ARVADA, BRIGHTON,  
COMMERCE CITY, FEDERAL HEIGHTS, NORTHGLENN, THORNTON,  
WESTMINSTER, AND THE TOWN OF BENNETT FOR DISTRIBUTING THE STATE  
FUNDS RECEIVED THROUGH THE CENSUS OUTREACH GRANT PROGRAM  
PURSUANT TO C.R.S. § 24-32-125**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Colorado Revised Statute § 24-32-125, in advance of the 2020 Census to be conducted by the federal United States census bureau in 2020 to determine the number of people living in the United States, the State of Colorado (“State”) has created the 2020 Census Outreach Grant Program and set aside funding for this grant program to be allocated to local governments and other organizations throughout the State; and

WHEREAS, Adams County was awarded \$420,000 of this grant money for a regional outreach effort; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds are intended to fund “Community Hubs,” which are designed to allow residents to participate in the 2020 Census onsite and fund outreach efforts to let residents know about these Hubs and facilitate their completion of the Census; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) and Adams County have negotiated the Intergovernmental Agreement between Adams County, Colorado and the Cities of Arvada, Brighton, Commerce City, Federal Heights, Northglenn, Thornton, Westminster, and the Town of Bennett for Distributing the State Funds Received through the Census Outreach Grant Program, attached as Exhibit A (“Intergovernmental Agreement”) to establish the parties’ respective responsibilities concerning the distribution of \$30,000 of these grant funds to the City and the City’s census outreach responsibilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Intergovernmental Agreement is and shall be in the interest of the public’s health, safety, and welfare, for a valid public purpose, and supported by a public need and is hereby approved, substantially in the form attached as Exhibit “A.”
2. The Mayor and the City Clerk are authorized and directed to sign and attest the Intergovernmental Agreement on behalf of the City of Commerce City.
