

**RESOLUTION APPROVING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY AND THE REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION
DISTRICT (“RTD”) REGARDING ARTWORK FOR THE NORTH METRO RAIL
LINE**

WHEREAS, RTD will operate the North Metro Rail Line (“NMRL”) consisting of commuter rail transit connecting Denver Union Station with Adams County, the City and County of Denver, the City of Northglenn, the City of Thornton, and the City of Commerce City (“City”); and

WHEREAS, RTD and the City support public artwork and agree that public art enhances the areas where such artwork is located; and

WHEREAS, the City and District have negotiated the Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Artwork for the North Metro Rail Line, attached as Exhibit A (“Intergovernmental Agreement”) to establish the parties respective responsibilities concerning the installation of art pieces and artwork wraps at certain rail stations along the NMRL.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Intergovernmental Agreement is and shall be in the interest of the public’s health, safety, and welfare, for a valid public purpose, and supported by a public need and is hereby approved, substantially in the form attached as Exhibit “A.”
2. The Mayor and the City Clerk are authorized and directed to sign and attest the Intergovernmental Agreement on behalf of the City of Commerce City.
