AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2020 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS THROUGH THE CARES ACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$246,587 AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The 2020 Budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado is amended to recognize the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds provided through the CARES Act in the amount of \$246,587 for COVID-19 response projects to assist city residents and small businesses and the expenditure thereof is hereby authorized as will be provided in the amended 2019 Annual Action Plan (Fund 395).

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
