Commerce

- Commerce City Parks, Recreation & Golf Department (CCPRG) provides recreation-based basketball leagues for boys and Girls in grades K-6.
- CCPRG partners with Adams County School District 14 (ACSD14) to provide practice courts within children's neighborhoods.

- More than 275 young athletes per year practice at ACSD14 elementary schools.
- Over 1700 elementary students participate in organized sports, physical education and general activities in the gymnasiums.



- ACSD14 is under construction to replace one school (Alsup Elementary)
- Other ACSD14 elementary schools built in the 1950's are in great need of renovation.



CCPRG has been working with ACSD14 regarding improvements at the following elementary schools:

- Central Elementary built in 1954
- Dupont Elementary built in 1956
- Kemp Elementary built in 1958
- Rosehill Elementary built 1952

Commerce

- The recommended improvements create an updated, safe and welcoming environment.
- CCPRG and ACSD14 have a history of working together to improve sports fields, playgrounds and other park & recreation amenities for students, families and residents in the community.

Improvements

Improvements include: wood floor resurfacing (Kemp & Rosehill), installation of rubber flooring (Central & Dupont) including striping & school logos on floors at all four sites; installation of electrical & structural supports in the ceiling necessary for new basketball backboards at all four sites.
