

**RESOLUTION REGARDING THE NAMING OF THE INCLUSIVE PLAY
STRUCTURE AT VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) is constructing an inclusive play structure as part of the renovation of Veterans Memorial Park at 6015 Forest Dr. as part of the capital improvement program;

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2014, this City Council adopted Resolution 2014-96 amended Council Policy #CP-7 regarding the procedure for naming City facilities;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Council Policy #CP-7, the Parks, Recreation & Golf Department conducted a naming contest to solicit and receive naming suggestions for the inclusive play structure;

WHEREAS, after considering the suggestions of the public, the Parks, Recreation & Golf Advisory Committee recommended the name “Eagles Nest” for the inclusive play structure based on the theme of the area and schematic for the play structure;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

1. The adoption of name “Eagles Nest” complies with Council Policy #CP-7 and would be in the best interests of the residents of the City of Commerce City.
2. The inclusive play structure located in Veterans Memorial Park at 6015 Forest Dr. shall be and is named “Eagles Nest.”
