# COVID Golf Division Modifications (overview)

- Golf course completely closed for 34 days; restaurant closed more than 2 months
- Staff completed training on sanitation, disinfecting buildings, furniture, and equipment
- All staff are required to wear face coverings while in buildings or near guests
- Maintenance staff was able to complete projects during closure (fairways, greens, etc.)
- Greatest impact was on restaurant; 50% reduction in dining capacity
- Indoor waiting areas eliminated in clubhouse to reduce gatherings
- Outdoor patio area utilized as much as possible for social distancing
- Golf participation consistent throughout the season (easy to distance from others)
- Golf programs such as 9 & Dine, Golf Divas, etc. canceled for safety
- Only tournaments with individual tee time starts allowed (no “shotgun starts”)
- Safety measures in place at touch-points throughout the course (carts, flags, etc.)

Golf course maintenance projects increased during 34 day closure.
