RESOLUTION APPROVING RENEWAL OF TYLER TECHNOLOGIES ENTERPRISE AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE AND USE OF TYLER NEW WORLD TECHNOLOGIES SOFTWARE

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City ("City") has previously contracted with Tyler Technologies, Inc. ("Tyler") via an Enterprise Agreement for licensing, upgrades, maintenance, and support for New World Technologies software, which platforms include New World Enterprise Resource Planning (a.k.a "New World" or "New World ERP") and eSuite (a.k.a "HR Portal") ("Products and Services");

WHEREAS, the City's current Enterprise Agreement is set to expire on September 30, 2020, and City staff has recommended that the City re- execute a new 3-year Enterprise Agreement with Tyler to enable the City to continue using the New World Products and Services without disruption;

WHEREAS, the City Manager has approved of the procurement without competition pursuant to the City's Procurement Policy; and

WHEREAS, the cost to the City of the purchase will exceed \$250,000.00 and, pursuant to the City's procurement policies and the City Manager's commitment to the City Council, the City Council must approve any procurement in excess of \$250,000.00.

WHEREAS, the cost to the City for the Services over the anticipated life of the contract will exceed \$250,000.00 and, pursuant to the City's procurement policies and the City Manager's commitment to the City Council, the City Council must approve any procurement in excess of \$250,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council hereby finds and determines that the renewal of the Tyler New World Enterprise Agreement is and shall be in the best interests of the residents of the City.

2. The total base Agreement amount of \$377,720.00 is hereby accepted, subject to successful negotiation and execution of a written contract.

3. Upon successful finalization of the contract documents and approval as to form by the City Attorney, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk to attest, the contract on behalf of the City of Commerce City.
