- 2. This resolution reappropriates and confirms use of the previously appropriated URA fund balance for the project. There is hereby recognized in the CCURA'S 2020 budget and appropriated in that budget as follows, for a total of \$6,252,400:

MHGP Project (Storm Water Escrow; Affordable Housing \$6,252,400 Loan; Closing Expenses)
