


### Summary of Impacts to Public Works Right-of-Way and Open Space Maintenance Costs Based on Proposed Ordinance Revisions

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### Summary of Impacts to ROW Maintenance Based on Proposed Ordinance

### Estimated Right-of Way Maintenance Budget Implications Associated With Proposed Ordinance

- Current right-of-way mowing practice
  - 82.2 miles 24' swath (2 passes w/mower), 3 mowings per season
    - In-House \$114,000/YR (O&M only no additional capital equipment cost required)
- Proposed Ordinance (w/AG Exception)
  - 56.2 miles Mow from edge of street to adjacent property line requiring additional pass with mower in most instances, apply 8" growth height restriction (estimated 7 mowings per season)
    - In-House Additional \$125,000/YR to include about \$13.5K for AG Exception (O&M only)
      - Requires \$589,000 Capital Equipment Cost (with associated O&M) in YR 1
    - Contractor Additional \$178,000/YR to include about \$19.2K for AG Exception (O&M only no additional capital equipment cost required)

### Estimated Right-of Way Maintenance Budget Implications Associated With Proposed Ordinance

- If the City retained responsibility for the 32.7 miles of ROW the Proposed Ordinance would transfer to the adjacent property owner
  - 32.7 miles Mow from edge of street to adjacent property line requiring additional pass with mower needed in most instances, apply 8" growth height restriction (estimated 7 mowings per season)
    - In-House Additional \$63,000/YR (O&M only)
      - Requires \$589,000 Capital Equipment Cost (with associated O&M) in YR 1
    - Contractor Additional \$90,000/YR (O&M only no additional capital equipment cost required)
- Staff Recommendation Transfer 32.7 miles of ROW to adjacent property owner, as per the Proposed Ordinance

Proposed Ordinance (w/AG Exception)	Mow from edge of pavement to property line, apply 8" growth height restriction, estimated 7 mowings per season	56.4	\$125,000	\$178,000
Staff Suggested Alternative	Mow 24' wide swath (instead of mowing from edge of pavement to property line), apply 8" growth height restriction, estimated 7 mowings per season	56.4	\$82,500	\$118,000

\*NOTE\* In-House requires \$589,000 Capital Equipment Cost (with associated O&M) in YR 1 for Proposed Ordinance and Suggested Alternative

### Estimated Open Space/Drainageway Maintenance Budget Implications Based On Proposed Ordinance

#### • Current Open Space Mowing Practice

- 143 acres Perimeter mowing (trail edges, ROW edges and fence lines only)
  - In-House \$39,000 (O&M only no additional capital equipment cost required)

#### • Proposed Ordinance

- 744 acres Mowing entire site, 16" growth height restriction, 4 mowings
  - In-House Additional \$59,000/YR (O&M only)
    - Requires \$130,000 Capital Equipment Cost in YR 1
  - **Contractor Additional \$85,000/YR** (O&M only no additional capital equipment cost required)
- Staff Recommendation Exempt City Designated Open Spaces/Drainageways From Proposed Ordinance....continue to apply current Open Space Mowing Practice

### Public Works Open Space/Drainageway Maintenance Practices

- Rationale To Exempt City Designated Open Spaces/Drainageways
- 16" maximum growth height restriction for undeveloped property over one acre is not conducive to the management and restoration of open space
  - Frequent mowings are detrimental to growing or maintaining healthy stands of native grasses
    - Significantly reduces ability to effectively restore open space to native grasslands
    - Mowing too frequently or at wrong times stresses native grasses and can encourage weed growth and propagation

### Estimated Equipment Budget Implications Associated With Proposed Ordinance

- Additional Equipment Costs for ROW Maintenance \$556,000
  - Tractor/Flail mowers (4) @ \$130,000 = \$520,000
  - Rough/Slope mowers (2) @ 18,000 = \$36,000
- Additional Equipment Cost for Open Space Maintenance \$130,000
  - Tractor/Flail mower (1) @ \$130,000
    - Recommended Open Space/Drainageway exemption would negate the need for this additional tractor/flail mower
- Annual cost for equipment maintenance and fuel \$33,000
