

- G. Community Outreach, Notification, Reporting & Oversight; Hazards & Emergencies. Operator shall comply with these standards to: protect human health and safety; prevent damage to property; and prevent unreasonable interference with the public welfare. These standards are established to improve and to prevent degradation to the quality of life and the general welfare in the City.
 - 1. Outreach to Affected Residents.

- a. Operator shall maintain a list, updated annually, of the residents and business owners within ¼ mile (1320'2,000') of an Oil and Gas Location Well Site ("Affected Residents").
- b. Operator shall create a community outreach plan for an Oil and Gas Location proposed within 2,000 feet of a Residential Building Unit, High Occupancy Building Unit, or School Facility. The plan shall provide for consultation, outreach, and engagement plan that includes:
 - i. A description of any measures taken to directly mitigate adverse impacts to the Affected Residents;
 - ii. Certification that written materials have been and will be provided in all languages spoken by 5% or more of the population in the census block group where the proposed Oil and Gas Location is located and those census block groups within 2,000 feet of the proposed Oil and Gas Location; and
 - The proposed date, time, and location of any public meeting(s) that are held at a location in close proximity to the Affected Residents. The Operator will provide child care and interpretation services at such a public meeting upon request.
 - iv. <u>Provide at least fourteen (14) days advanced written notice to Affected Residents of mobilization in, rig up (MIRU);</u>
