AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2021 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE ADAMS COUNTY OPEN SPACE GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$92,500 FOR THE TURNBERRY PARK SKATE SPOT PROJECT AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. An amendment is made to the 2021 Budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from Adams County Open Space Grant in the amount of \$92,500. The funds are to be used for the Turnberry Park Skate Spot project and such expenditure thereof is hereby authorized (Fund 395).

SECTION 2. The City Manager is authorized and directed to sign, and the City Clerk to attest, an intergovernmental agreement with Adams County to implement the grant.
