RESOLUTION MODIFYING THE PARKS, RECREATION AND GOLF ADVISORY COMMITTEE

NO. **DRAFT** (4-20-21)

WHEREAS, the City Council approved Resolution No. 2016-12 on March 21, 2016, to establish the Parks, Recreation and Golf Advisory Committee to provide citizens with the opportunity to contribute to making Commerce City a Quality Community for a Lifetime promoting active, healthy lifestyles through parks, recreation and golf; and

WHEREAS, the Parks, Recreation and Golf Advisory Committee has recommended updating the purpose provisions of Resolution No. 2016-12.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Paragraph 2 of Resolution No. 2016-12 is amended to read as follows:

<u>Purpose</u>. The committee shall have the purpose of advising the City Council and City staff, through its designated representative and a City staff liaison, on matters related to City owned and controlled parks, trails, open space, golf and recreation areas and facilities and recreation, golf and parks programs and services conducted both within and without the boundaries of the City. The committee will:

- a. make recommendations pertaining to the planning, development, regulation, maintenance, capital repair and replacement (capital improvement project annual review) and operation of facilities, programs, and services, fees and charges and issues brought forth by the community, boards and commissions and City staff;
- b. participate in public engagement processes related to the committee's work;
- c. participate in capital project milestones such as groundbreakings, progress tours, and grand openings;
- d. participate in the naming of parks, recreation, and golf facilities in accordance with applicable Council Policies;
- e. promote public awareness and understanding of parks, recreation, and golf programs, services, facilities, and projects; and
- f. advocate for park, recreation and golf programs and services that support: health and wellness essential to improve individual and community-level health; equitable access for all people; and conservation providing critical green spaces that connect people to the outdoors and are beneficial to our environment.
- 2. Resolution No. 2016-12 is repealed and replaced to the extent it is not consistent with this resolution.
- 3. This resolution shall not affect any appointments to or decisions made by the Parks, Recreation and Golf Advisory Committee before its effective date.
