G. MAYOR'S ROLE

- 1. While each Mayor is unique as a person, the performance of the role as Mayor is always subject to the requirements of the City Charter, ordinances and state and federal law.
- 2. The Mayor is the ceremonial head of the City <u>and may perform acts</u> to the extent authorized by the City Council, City Charter and state and federal law. <u>Except in the performance of such role and such acts as are authorized by applicable law, the Mayor shall be subject to the same limitations and requirements as all Council members.</u>
- 3. The Mayor will communicate regularly with the City Manager and keep Council members fully informed.
- 4. The Mayor will seek to guide discussion and enable consensus-building and positive interactions through the management of meetings.
- 3.5. The Mayor will seek to guide discussion and enable consensus-building and positive interactions through the management of meetings.
 - 4.6. The Mayor will communicate with board and board and commission chairs.
- 5.7. The Mayor will discuss with Council the work and achievements of the City Manager and City Attorney work and achievements.
- 6.8. The Mayor will <u>not chastise or criticize staff in public</u> and will caution Council members <u>if they chastise</u> or <u>criticizing</u> or <u>criticizing</u> staff in public. <u>Council members</u>, <u>including the Mayor</u>, <u>will discuss concerns with staff or performance with the City Manager or City Attorney</u>, as appropriate.
- 7.9. Council and the Mayor willshould stay positive at all times in the conduct of Council meetings.
- 8.10. Subject to a need to maintain necessary confidentiality, the Mayor will report to Council members all meetings to be held with developers, builders and businesses and get their input and keep them advised of processes and negotiations and give information and detail after the fact. No agreements shall be reached with developers on behalf of the Council without Council approval. The Mayor is not authorized to negotiate agreements with developers on behalf of the City except when authorized by law and Council.
- 9.11. The Mayor shouldwill_continually strive to provide new efficiencies in conducting Council business, adhering to Council policies and manage an effective business meeting. The Mayor should seek to educate Council members about Council policies and procedure.
