Attorney Johnson make opening comments regarding zoning, compliance and reviewed preliminary findings.

Garretson was sworn and testified on the petition results, gave a description of the area within the boundary, survey coverage, and petitioning procedures.

Botkin testified to his role in the business, his educational and professional background, other licenses held, products to be sold, lack of prior violations, security measures to be taken, hours of operation, staffing, employee training procedures, inventory management and odor mitigation. The hearing officer questioned Botkin about the diagram. Attorney Swann commended the licensee on no odor complaints, asked about employee training, and asked for clarification on lease documents.

Kirvan testified to his educational and professional experience, other business owned, his role and responsibilities in the proposed operation, and his familiarity with marijuana laws and ordinances.
