A RESOLUTION AMENDING COUNCIL POLICY #CP-16 TO FORMALLY ADOPT BOB'S RULES OF ORDER FOR COLORADO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (2023)

Summary and Background Information:

The City of Commerce City is authorized to adopt procedures to govern the conduct of meetings and rules governing the decision-making process. Currently, the City Council uses Robert's Rules of Order as a general guide for meeting conduct, but has not formally adopted any rules of order to govern meeting procedures.
