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2015 Trash Contract Bid Options

Summary and Background Information :

The *2009 Municipal Trash and Recyclables Collection Agreement* officially expired on December 31, 2013. The contract was extended for one additional year with City Council's direction to go out to competitive bid and award a new contract for 2015. This presentation is intended to provide service options for the City Council to consider for inclusion in the formal Request for Proposal.

Base Service:

- Unlimited weekly trash service
- Bi-weekly curbside recycling
- Two (2) 18-gallon recycling totes provided per unit for recycling
- Homeowners provide their own bags and trash receptacles
- Free large item pick-up
- Trash and recycling services for all City facilities

Add Alternates:

1. Eliminate free large item pick-up
2. Eliminate fee large item pick-up and provide one city-wide clean-up event
3. Provide one (1) 96-gallon refuse container per unit
4. Provide one (1) 96-gallon recycling container per unit

These options are being considered based on historical comments and questions from City Council to help manage costs while still providing essential refuse collection services.
