RESOLUTION APPROVING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT REGARDING HIGHWAY 2 IMPROVEMENTS WITH SOUTH ADAMS COUNTY WATER AND SANITATION DISTRICT

## Summary and Background Information :

The City and the South Adams County Water and Sanitation District (SACWSD), in the interest of efficiency, desire to include certain water main improvements in the Highway 2 Widening Project. An intergovernmental agreement has been developed to facilitate the completion of these improvements and to establish terms for the financing of the improvements.

Approximately 7,200 lineal feet of 8-inch diameter water main will be installed through an open cut in the pavement. Approximately 285 lineal feet of 8-inch diameter water main will be installed through horizontal directional drilling. Twelve (12) fire hydrants will be installed. The estimated total cost for these improvements \$1,152,926.51, which includes a contingency amount.

Per the agreement, SACWSD will pay the City 90% of the cost of the improvements within thirty (30) days of the agreement and the remainder at project completion. The SACWSD Board has already approved this agreement.
