## RESOLUTION APPROVING 2016 AMENDED BYLAWS OF THE URBAN RENEWAL AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY

### Summary and Background Information:

Per HB 1348, URA boards across the state required to add 3 seats, coming from:

- A. Special Districts - by agreement of all taxing districts
- B. County - by County designation
- C. School District - by agreement of all taxing districts

URA may elect to add additional seat to ensure an odd number of votes, and per HB1348, that seat is to be appointed by Mayor. By-Laws outline total number of seats, which needs to be amended to allow for state-required additional seats.
