## Summary and Background Information :

he water acquisition fee escalator was frozen for 2017 and 2018. On January 1, 2019, it returns to 10 percent per year scalation. Staff researched the annual escalation in the price of water rights. On April 17, Council directed staff to agage outside expertise from WestWater Research, LLC. to examine water rights prices for the Denver area.

VestWater Research, LLC. has submitted a report showing South Platte River Basin Denver-area prices. The report also camined indices to see if an index could serve the City as an indicator for future fee escalation. Their conclusion was not not existing index will serve as a good indicator of water price changes. Their report recommends that the escalation at the set at 7.75% per year and that the City re-examine the fee every three years.
