## **Summary and Background Information:**

The City of Commerce City is requesting approval for the annexation of 0.69 acres that consists of one portion of the Highway 2 right-of-way between E 96th Avenue, and E 104<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The subject property will be utilized as additional right-of-way for the city's expansion of Highway 2 from two lanes to four lanes. Two additional annexations (AN-241-17 and AN-242-17) are being processed concurrently with this request, in order to meet Colorado Revised Statutes (CRS) contiguity requirements for annexations. The subject property is currently designated as right-of way.

The City of Commerce City does not assign zoning designations to right-of-way, therefore there will be no associated zoning case with this annexation. As this is a city owned property and city initiated annexation, no annexation petition will be required as part of this request.
