AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2017 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE STATE OF COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FUNDING AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,160,000 FOR THE SAND CREEK OPEN SPACE REMEDIATION & RESTORATION PROJECT AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

**Summary and Background Information**: The City was awarded funding from the state in 2012 and spent a portion of it to acquire a couple of properties along Sand Creek (Weaver or WE Holdings and Multi-Contractors.) This funding of \$1,160,000 will be used for remediation and restoration of the two properties.
