AN ORDINANCE INCLUDING CERTAIN LANDS INTO THE COMMERCE CITY E-470 COMMERCIAL AREA GENERAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

Summary and Background Information:

Property Information

- The property was considered for annexation by City Council earlier in the evening on November 6th with a zoning of PUD. The name of the PUD is DIA Tech Center and it is proposed to have employment development north of E. 81st Avenue and west towards the Wildlife Refuge boundary and commercial development towards Tower Road.
- The applicant is planning to plat this property for future employment uses once the annexation is complete, although a specific user has not been identified.
- The applicant is proposing to include this newly annexed portion of DIATC into the ECAGID, to be consistent with the remainder of the DIATC development.

Inclusion information

- The GID inclusion petition resulted from preparing this site for development and acquiring water resources from South Adams County Water and Sanitation District (SACWSD).
- The applicant is in the process of including the property into SACWSD.
