- The property was considered for annexation by City Council earlier in the evening on November 6<sup>th</sup> with a zoning of PUD. The name of the PUD is DIA Tech Center and it is proposed to have employment development north of E. 81<sup>st</sup> Avenue and west towards the Wildlife Refuge boundary and commercial development towards Tower Road.
- The applicant is planning to plat this property for future employment uses once the annexation is complete, although a specific user has not been identified.
- The applicant is proposing to include this newly annexed portion of DIATC into the ECAGID, to be consistent with the remainder of the DIATC development.
