Resolution Approving the Adams County Collaborative Transportation Planning Agreement to establish the Adams County Council of Governments (ADCOG) Subregional Forum Process among the city of Arvada, the city of Aurora, the town of Bennett, the city of Brighton, the city of Commerce City, the city of Federal Heights, the town of Lochbuie, the city of Northglenn, the city of Thornton, the city of Westminster and Adams County.

Summary and Background Information: DRCOG is changing its Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) submittal process from a centralized Regional Model to a new Dual Model that comprises both a Regional Funding process and a Subregional Funding process. In the Dual Model, the Subregions will collaborate and submit projects to compete directly with other subregions, CDOT and RTD for Regional Pot Funding. The agencies within Adams County will develop a list of recommended projects to use for the ADCOG Subregional Forum Funding. This agreement outlines the process for establishing a Forum for soliciting and evaluating projects.
