Proclamation Declaring May 5-11 as National Small Business Week in Commerce City

Summary and Background Information:

Every year since 1963, the President of the United States has issued a proclamation announcing National Small Business Week, which recognizes the critical contributions of America's entrepreneurs and small business owners. This year's Small Business Week is May 5-11, 2019.

Small businesses are an important component of Commerce City's economy. There are over 1,400 businesses within the city and over 80 percent of them have less than 20 employees.
