**Summary and Background Information**: The City Council, in a previous meeting, acting through by consensus and upon an affirmative vote, directed the City Attorney to draft and present for review, consideration, and approval, an amendment to CCRMC sec. 2-2003 to modify two items. First, to change the time of automatic adjournment to 10:30 p.m. thereby striking the 4 1/2 hour limit. Second, to amend the timing and duration of motions to extend meetings to allow greater flexibility as may be necessitated by the facts and circumstances of the meeting.
