AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2014 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE KAISER PERMANENTE WALK & WHEEL GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$12,275 TO FUND THE WELLNESS COMMITTEE PROGRAM AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

**Summary and Background Information** : Kaiser Permanente offered a "Walk & Wheel Colorado: Increasing Walking & Biking in Colorado Through Employer Action" grant opportunity. The grant fits very well with the mission of the Employee Wellness Committee. The Employee Wellness Committee decided to submit an application to assist with costs for the City's wellness programs. Funds from this award will pay for 1) under desk bikes, 2) pedometers, 3) educational speakers and 4) incentives/prizes.
