Summary and Background Information :

For the 27th consecutive year, the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting has been awarded to the City of Commerce City by the Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA) for its comprehensive annual financial report (CAFR). The Certificate of Achievement is the highest form of recognition in the area of governmental accounting and financial reporting, and its attainment represents a significant accomplishment by a government and its management.

As the department responsible for preparing the award-winning CAFR, the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting is awarded to the Commerce City Department of Finance.
