AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2015 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE ADAMS COUNTY OPEN SPACE GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$359,450 FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE SECOND CREEK COMMUNITY PARK EXPANSION ACQUISITION PROJECT AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

Summary and Background Information : Funds will be used to acquire property to expand an existing community park site. This property is currently owned by a developer and is planned for commercial development. Acquiring this property will allow a larger portion of an adjacent property already owned by the city to remain as minimally developed open space.
