### Recognition of the CPRA 2016 Fellow Award

**Summary and Background Information** : The Fellow Award is the highest honor bestowed upon a Colorado Parks & Recreation Association (CPRA) member. Fellow Award nominees must have worked a minimum of eight years full time service in a leadership capacity, with a minimum of five years full time service in Colorado. Additionally, the nominees must excel in the following skill sets: leadership; strategic thinking and planning; partner/coalition building; innovation and service.
