AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2016 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$386,340 FOR SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION AND BUS STOP IMPROVEMENTS AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

**Summary and Background Information :** Beginning the 2016-2017 program year, the city became a direct recipient of funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. The city previously received a CDBG allocation through Adams County. This will be the first year as a direct recipient.
