RESOLUTION REGARDING POSTING LOCATIONS FOR ORDINANCES AND PUBLIC MEETINGS

Summary and Background Information : The Colorado Open Meetings Law declares that the public cannot exercise its right to attend open meetings unless provided sufficient notice. The statute requires annual notification of a public place or places for posting such notices within the boundaries of the local public body. Commerce City's Home Rule Charter directs council to designate two public places for posting ordinances. The locations are identified in the body of the resolution.
