AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2017 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,000 FOR CLICK IT OR TICKET ENFORCEMENT EFFORTS AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

**Summary and Background Information** : CDOT provides grant dollars to provide overtime enforcement of Colorado's child passenger safety and adult occupant protection laws through speeding and other aggressive/hazardous driving contacts during authorized time periods. Funds will be used to strictly enforce all child, teen and adult driving violations with a zero tolerance related to seat belt laws.
