SECOND AND FINAL READING OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2022 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$422,541 AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF

Summary & Background

Beginning with the 2016-2017 program year, the city became a direct recipient of funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. This ordinance accepts the funds awarded for program year 2022.

The 2022 Annual Action Plan will be presented by Community Development staff. This ordinance was drafted to include the funding submitted for your consideration/approval. The projects to be presented in the 2022 Annual Action Plan are public services, public works, economic development, housing rehabilitation, and/or administration costs.
