

ORDINANCE NO. 2770

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1291, WHICH ESTABLISHED THE COMMERCE CITY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISPOSAL ENTERPRISE AND ITS RELATED FUND, TO COMPLY WITH CURRENT ACCOUNTING STANDARDS.

WHEREAS, in 1999, the City of Commerce City (“City”) adopted Ordinance 1291 which established an enterprise to manage the solid waste disposal activities within the City pursuant to Section 20, Article X of the Colorado Constitution (“Enterprise”);

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 1291, the City created the Commerce City Solid Waste Management Disposal Enterprise Fund (“Fund”) to hold all revenue of the Enterprise; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City and the Enterprise to amend Section 1 of Ordinance 1291 to comply with current accounting standards for the Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend Ordinance 1291 as authorized by Section 5.7 of the City Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be supported and authorized by law and in the best interests of and necessary for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the public.

SECTION 2. Amendment. Section 1 of Ordinance 1291 is hereby amended and reenacted as reflected in Exhibit A herein.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
